



On-Mountain Driving Requirements

1. Mountain Access must be arranged and approved prior through Mountain Operations.
2. High clearance four-wheel drive vehicles are required to access most locations in the summer.
3. A speed limit of 25 mph is mandatory on all on-mountain roads; however, the safe speed of travel will generally be less than 25 mph. Reduce speed in congested areas, bike x-ings, blind curves and sharp breakovers. Keep speed down to prevent excessive dust clouds.
4. Bikers, hikers and horses and persons recreating have the right of way on the mountain.
5. Stay on designated roads and use 4wd-on all mountain roads to reduce road damage.
6. Parking vehicles on mountain access roads within Resort Property, is not permitted. Exceptions must be approved through Mountain Operations.
7. All vehicles, other than company vehicles, must have a valid road permit displayed in the windshield. Failure to follow policies will result in revocation of permit.
8. Contractor shall ensure that all gates used by Contractor to access the Site shall remain closed and secured when not in use.
