

On-Mountain Driving Requirements

- 1. Mountain Access must be arranged and approved prior through Mountain Operations.
- 2. High clearance four-wheel drive vehicles are required to access most locations in the summer.
- 3. A speed limit of 25 mph is mandatory on all on-mountain roads; however, the safe speed of travel will generally be less than 25 mph. Reduce speed in congested areas, bike x-ings, blind curves and sharp breakovers. Keep speed down to prevent excessive dust clouds.
- 4. Bikers, hikers and horses and persons recreating have the right of way on the mountain.
- 5. Stay on designated roads and use 4wd-on all mountain roads to reduce road damage.
- 6. Parking vehicles on mountain access roads within Resort Property, is not permitted. Exceptions must be approved through Mountain Operations.
- 7. All vehicles, other than company vehicles, must have a valid road permit displayed in the windshield. Failure to follow policies will result in revocation of permit.
- 8. Contractor shall ensure that all gates used by Contractor to access the Site shall remain closed and secured when not in use.
